CRISTO REY HIGH SCHOOL

Cristo Rey is one of the very few Catholic High Schools in Detroit. It is definitely a college prep school—100% of the first graduation class this June were accepted to college. It is diverse: 60% of the students are female, 50% are Hispanic and 40% are African American. The school focuses on low-income families. There is this unique work-study program where each student is placed in a real job situation to earn a contribution to the cost of tuition. This experience is important in the personal and academic growth of the students. The school is located in the old Holy Redeemer High School building, 5679 West Vernor in SW Detroit. There is an open invitation for everyone to stop by and see what is happening here.

We have a specific invitation! Next Saturday, August 4, the cleanup campaign to get things ready for fall takes place. From 9-3 workers are invited to clean, paint, etc. Lunch will be provided. Retreat Update

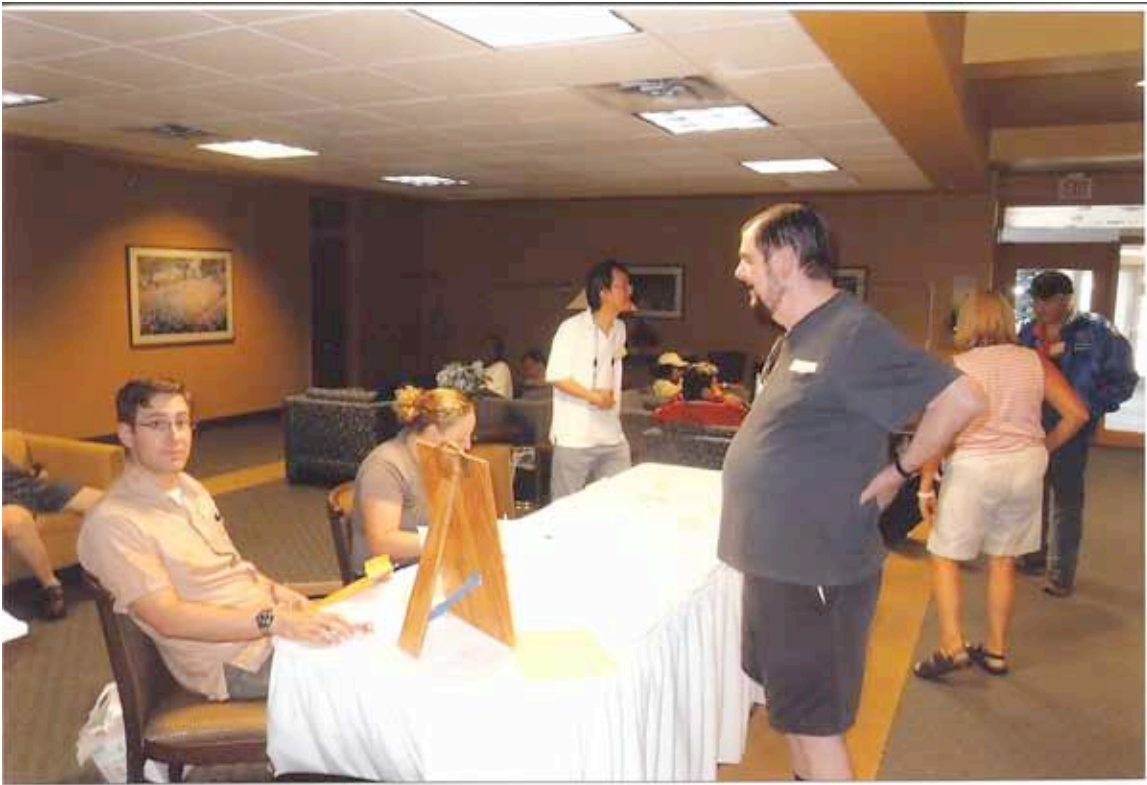
As most Rosary members know, Rosary sponsors five or six weekend retreats for developmentally disabled adults. What began as a Rosary effort now has extended to welcome participants from throughout the diocese. With the curtailment of diocesan outreach to developmentally disabled adults, Rosary's program takes on added importance.



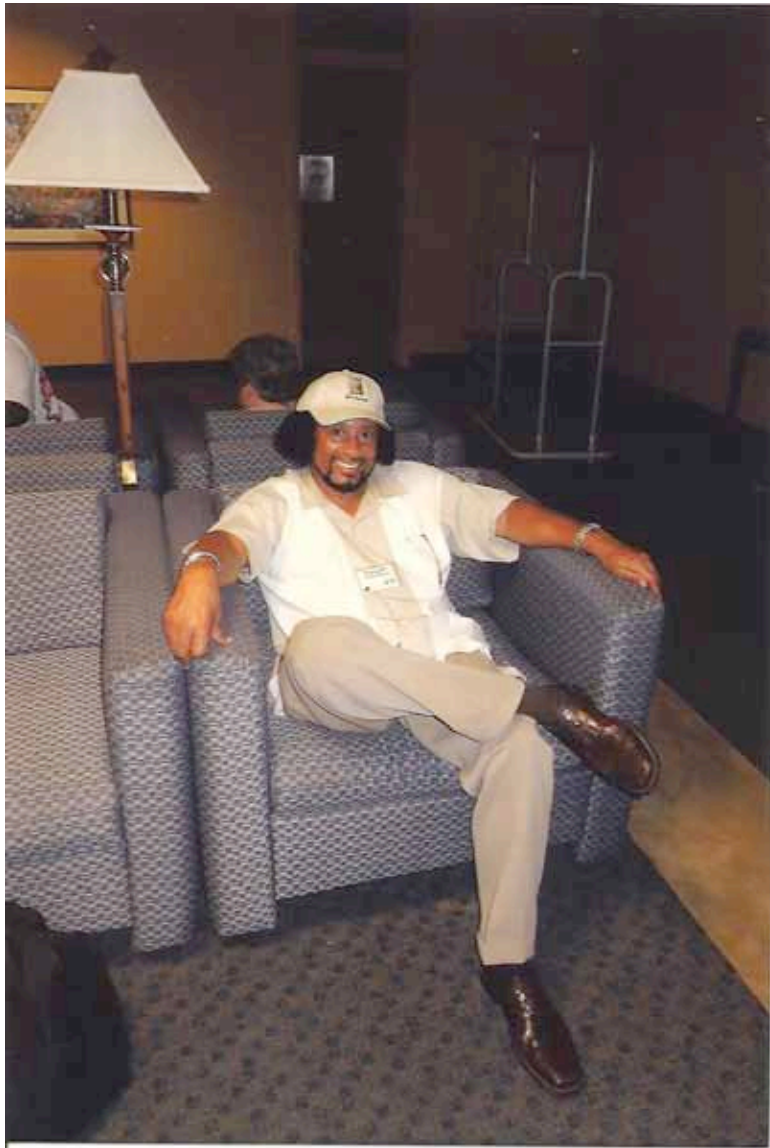
Columbiere Center, the former Jesuit seminary in Clarkston, North of Pontiac, is one of the most popular centers for the Rosary retreats. The feeling of being in a “college complete with dorm rooms, cafeteria, etc. appeals to so many participants who live in homes with little diversion. Participants enjoy interacting with Rosary leaders and adults from all over the diocese.
