MORE CRIME-FIGHTING ACTIONS

The Church in the City is seriously joining with all groups working to make Detroit a safer City. We've talked about the Speak UP campaign which is producing results. Another initiative is in progress now. We recognize that the abundance of illegal handguns in our City has a strong connection to the unacceptably high number of murders and shootings—even “accidental” shootings. Bishop Hanchon has asked Detroit Catholics to join in the current “buy-back” program, in which people can turn in handguns with no questions asked and receive a cash payment for them. This week and next we will be accepting whatever monetary donations you choose to give to go directly to the gun buy-back plan. The plan is under the supervision of the Detroit Police Department. There will be various sites around the City—the number depends on the amount of money raised for the buy-back. We need to get involved in this program not only because we are very concerned about the deaths and injuries due to illegal guns in our City, but also because we want to make it known that Our Lady of the Rosary Church is dedicated to improving the quality of life in our City. The total amount contributed will be forwarded to our Vicar, with the clear designation that this represents Rosary Parish.

VOTER REGISTRATION

NOW is the time to make certain you are registered to vote in the Presidential Election in November. If you have previously voted, you are still registered. If you will be 18 by November, you are able to register to vote now. Sister Joan has registration forms, applications for absentee ballots and change of address forms. See her after Mass.
