TOGETHER IN FAITH

As it gets closer to the end of June, the deadline for plans to address the Archbishop's plans gets closer. After Mass today, Sunday, those interested in hearing where Rosary is in this process are invited to meet after Mass. If you've been reading the bulletin articles over that last few months, you should have a good idea of how this process has been working and what is expected of us. The Parish Council has met several times on these issues, and Rosary has met with representatives of neighboring parishes. If you have time, stop by the meeting—in the church, after the 10 AM Mass.

GUN BUY BACK PROGRAM

As announced last week, the Catholic church in the City is working with other churches and the Detroit Police Department to help end the culture of violence and death in our City. One primary focus is on the cause of so many problems---illegal handguns. A Gun Buy Back program has been started. People can turn in guns for a cash reward. Similar programs have been very successful. The money for the rewards can not come from the State or City; it comes from donations from churches, businesses and citizens. Each Vicariate of the Archdiocese—there are 4 Vicariates in Detroit—is coordinating collections from the member parishes for funds to use in the gun buy back. The original suggestion was that each parish should aim for at least \$300 in donations; this would provide a nice foundation for the buy back. At Rosary, we are accepting whatever donations people are comfortable giving. Either mark the check “Gun Buy Back” or use a blank envelope or one of the Offertory Collection envelopes with a large **X** across the face of the envelope, found near the entrance to the church. This will be the weekend for this collection (unless someone asks for another week!).

SCRIPTURE ON THE STREET

Deacon Bob is continuing his series of street sermons, sharing the Scripture with the congregation of our neighbors “on the move” who assemble on Milwaukee Avenue regularly. Last week, Deacon Bob used the text (John 14:2) which includes the line, “In my father's house there are many rooms.” He posed the question, “What sort of room would you like Jesus to prepare for you?” Responses were very thoughtful: “a peaceful blue room,” “a room without insects,” “a room where I can just rest and think”, etc. Deacon Bob charged the congregation to go out into the neighborhoods and engage others in this discussion, always spreading the Good News that God will look out for us and provide us with a place of safety and rest.
