SAFE CITY CAMPAIGN

This program is beginning to make an impact on our City. In the first four weeks of the Stand Up Speak Up focus, an increase of 21% in the number of

tips being phoned in has been reported. This is a remarkable start for this program sponsored by Detroit Churches.

FOCUS HOPE TRAINING

Thanks to recent grants, Focus:HOPE is able to offer some wonderful opportunities to 18 – 24 year olds. A 12 week program to become a machine operator, and a 15 week program in information technology will be enrolling soon. Plan to attend the open house, Wednesday, June 6, 11 – 5 at the Center, 1400 Oakman Blvd. Also, the offices are open every weekday from 8:30 – 4:30. Why not drop by and talk to a counselor about programs that might be just right for you? Some programs require a GED or high school diploma, others do not. All require passing a drug test. The opportunities are there!!

TOGETHER IN FAITH REVISITED

If you recall, the decisions from the Archdiocese that were announced last winter call for Rosary to “develop plans to merge with a neighboring parish.” Last week, the Parish Council met with Mr. James, the Archdiocesan coordinator for all City parishes. The Council has been addressing this requirement for the last several meetings. Clarification was needed. “Merger” would basically make one pastor responsible for more than one site, once the merger plan kicks in. This will happen when the financial situation of one parish is unstable, or when a parish is without a functioning pastor. Until either “trigger” occurs, the merger is simply a plan on paper. What can Rosary do? We must have a plan in place by the end of June—just the plan, not the physical merger. The suggestion is that we formulate a plan without naming the actual merger partner and continue to work on finding a receptive partner. Since our area has so many parishes already clustered/merged, it is a big problem to find a parish to work with. So far the suggestions have been St. Aloysius/St. Patrick and the Cathedral. (We would be the “Rosary campus of the Cathedral!) The Council has certain elements to be found in any plan: We must maintain our name, we must maintain our worship site, we must

continue our various ministries—retreats for the disabled, our community outreach, etc. At this point discussions are on-going. The Council plans a Parish assembly when we get down to specifics of a proposed plan.

MOVING ON

Many of us have gotten to know Fr. Santhus who has been living here since Easter. He is Catholic Chaplain at the Veteran's Hospital. Father has relocated, and is now living at the rectory of Sweetest Heart of Mary parish, closer to his job. He sends a message to the parish: "Your home was my home. "I was a stranger and you welcomed me." Thank you for your love, kindness and welcome. May God bless you all and your families, your loved ones and friends." We also wish Fr. Santhus success and God's blessing on his work.
