You are not asked to identify yourself or your location. You will never be contacted by police or asked to testify. If part of our parish's mission is to improve the quality of life for all, ending crime is a big part of this mission. It will take a while to reverse Detroit's "no snitching" mentality—but we must start somewhere. Please take some of the material being offered today and pass it on in your neighborhoods and to your friends. Isn't it about time the Catholic Church raised its voice against crime?
