SAFE CITY CAMPAIGN

Last week's emphasis on Stand Up Speak Up month is only the beginning of an Archdiocesan initiative to work with other churches in the City to fight the on-going problem with crime. Details will be announced soon, but the effort to increase safety in our City will involve a gun-buyback plan, job training programs for men and women in the 14-30 year old group, an increased Junior Cadet program by the Detroit Police Department starting with summer jobs and continuing through the year, and future programs to improve counseling to connect people and services, a Food Navigators program to provide breakfast and lunch to those under age 17 throughout the

summer and even a program to make athletic participation more available by locating more gyms that could be opened. It is important that we, as Catholics, are involved in these programs to improve the quality of life in our City.

FOCUS HOPE TRAINING

Thanks to recent grants, Focus:HOPE is able to offer some wonderful opportunities to 18 – 24 year olds. A 12 week program to become a machine operator, and a 15 week program in information technology will be enrolling soon. Plan to attend the open house, Wednesday, June 6, 11 – 5 at the Center, 1400 Oakman Blvd. Also, the offices are open every weekday from 8:30 – 4:30. Why not drop by and talk to a counselor about programs that might be just right for you? Some programs require a GED or high school diploma, others do not. All require passing a drug test. The opportunities are there!!

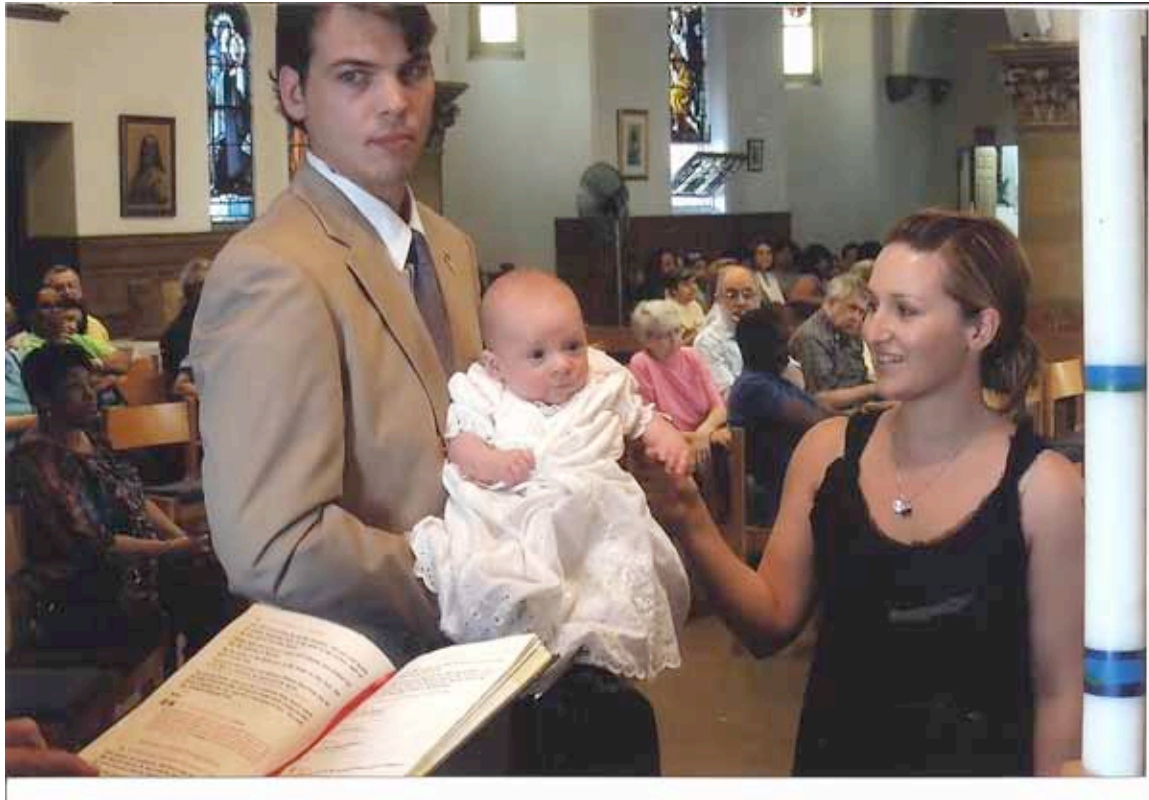

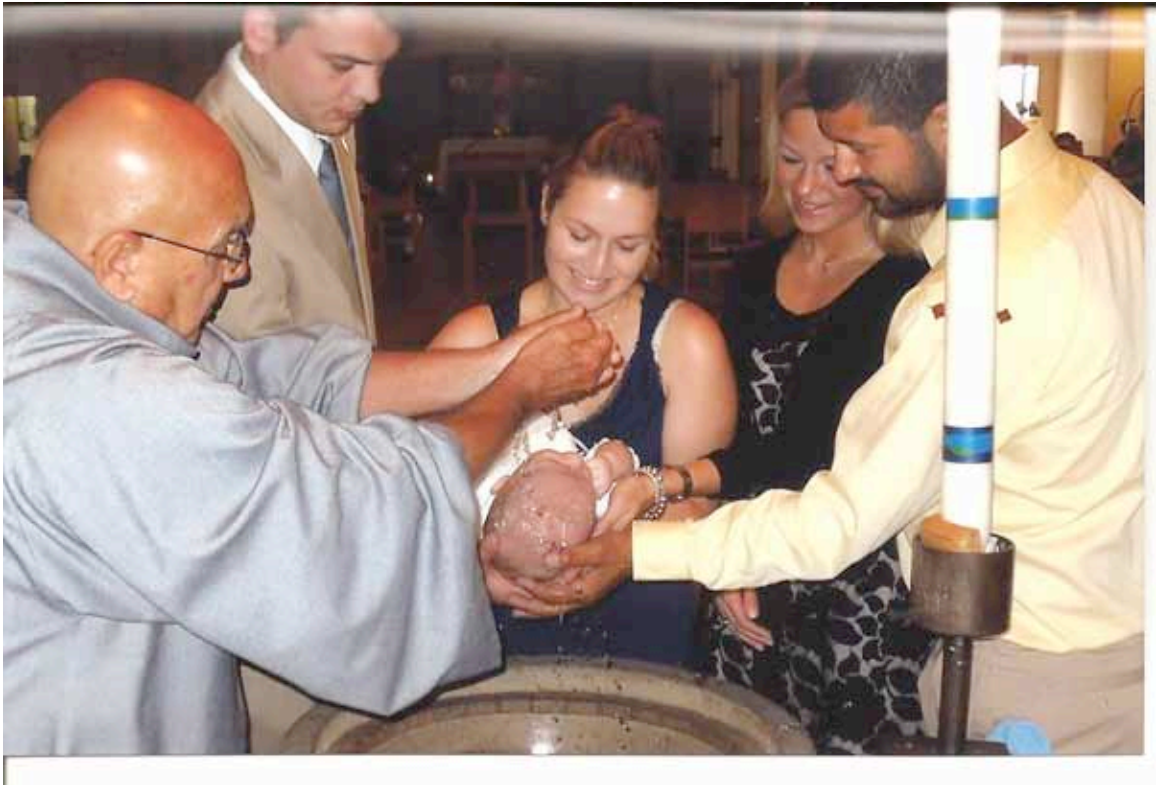
Last Week at Rosary
