His turnaround has been an inspiration to many who struggle with a particular vice or habit. This famous son of St. Monica was born in Africa and was one of the most intelligent men who ever lived. Though he had been brought up a Christian, his sins of impurity and his pride darkened his mind so much that he could not see or understand the Divine Truth. One day he heard about two men who had been converted on reading the life of St. Anthony, and he felt ashamed of himself. From then on, Augustine began a new life. He was baptized, and later became a priest, and a bishop, he founded of religious order, and has been heralded as on of the greatest writers and saints that ever lived.
