CAMPAIGN FOR HUMAN DEVELOPMENT

Each year at Thanksgiving time the collection for the Campaign for Human Development (CHD) is taken up. This collection funds projects here in the United States aimed at overcoming the conditions that keep people trapped in the cycle of poverty. The latest figures estimate 46.2 million Americans are living below the poverty line. Last year, the CHD generated almost 8 million dollars which went for community development and housing, family and community issues, economic development technical assistance and emergency funding. It should be noted that 25% of the money collected in the Archdiocese of Detroit is used to support anti-poverty programs right here. Envelopes are available this weekend. YEAR OF FAITH - ST. JOSEPHINE BAKHITA

St. Josephine Bakhita was born in Sudan in 1869. Sold as a slave she experienced the physical and moral humiliations and sufferings of slavery. The fright and the terrible experience she went through made her forget the name her parents gave her. Bakhita, which means "fortunate," was the name given to her by her kidnappers. Eventually she was purchased by a benevolent Italian consul, and then was entrusted to the Canossian Sisters of the Institute of Catechumens in Venice. It was there that that Bakhita came to know about God, whom "she had experienced in her heart without knowing who he was" since she was a child. Her humility, simplicity and constant smile won the hearts of all. When Mother Bakhita breathed her last a crowd quickly gathered at the convent to have a last look at their "Mother Moretta" (our Black Mother") and ask for her protection. The fame of her sanctity has spread to all the continents and many receive graces through her intercession.
