YEAR OF FAITH

SAINT MAURICE OF AGAUNUM AND COMPANIONS

St. Maurice was an officer in the Roman Emperor Maximian Herculius' army which consisted of Christians from Northern Egypt. Maximian sent out an order to all his legionnaires to offer sacrifices to the gods to insure victory over the peasant insurgents Bagaudae. Maurice and his companions refused. Again they were ordered to offer sacrifices to the gods and again they refused. In a display of power and authority Maximian ordered Maurice and his companions to be executed. To the very end Maurice and his companions encouraged one another in their loyalty to remain committed to Christ. St. Maurice and the unknown number of companions suffered martyrdom at Agaunum, in southwestern Switzerland.
