## **CHANGING LIVES TOGETHER**

After four years of “warnings,” the Changing Lives Together campaign is about to visit Rosary. At a meeting this week, some of the basics about the program were reviewed. Every parish in the diocese must participate. The idea is that a parish will pledge to raise 90% of its annual offertory collection within a three year period—by pledges. Of the money raised, 70% will remain in the parish for various projects, and 30% will go to the Archdiocese. For Rosary, the figures being talked about right now are;

**Goal: \$80,000**

**For Rosary: \$ 56,000**

**For the Diocese: \$24,000**

There will be a lot happening before anyone is actually asked to complete a pledge card. In fact, it will probably be March before pledging takes place. Between now and then, expect a lot of bulletin announcements, prayers, handouts, etc. Mr. Mark Filips is the designated contact person for Rosary from the organization running Changing Lives Together. Undoubtedly we will come to know him.

## **RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM**

We are starting our religious education and sacramental preparation programs again. Sessions will be held before Sunday Mass, at 9 AM. Religious education for all ages will be offered. In addition, those young people ready to make their First Communion, or to be confirmed should attend these sessions also. Special emphasis will be given to preparation for these sacraments. We need a strong commitment from parents, a strong desire to see their children learning the basics of the Catholic faith. This training will set the course for the future for these children as they deepen their involvement in the Church. Please do all you can to make this education program a success.
