The St. Vincent de Paul Society sponsors an annual fundraiser: The Friends of the Poor Walk. Money raised goes to help local St. Vincent de Paul Conferences with the various needs presented to them. This year's walk will be Saturday, September 29, starting at Milliken Park (1900 Atwater, just East of the Renaissance Center) and continuing along the Dequindre Cut—the old railroad track that has been turned into a space for walking and biking. Registration starts at 9 AM, and the walk starts at 10—although it can start any time YOU decide to start walking! You can pre-register on line, or with a St. Vincent de Paul member. The “walk” includes running, skating, biking, and any kind of human-powered transport, including wheel chairs! 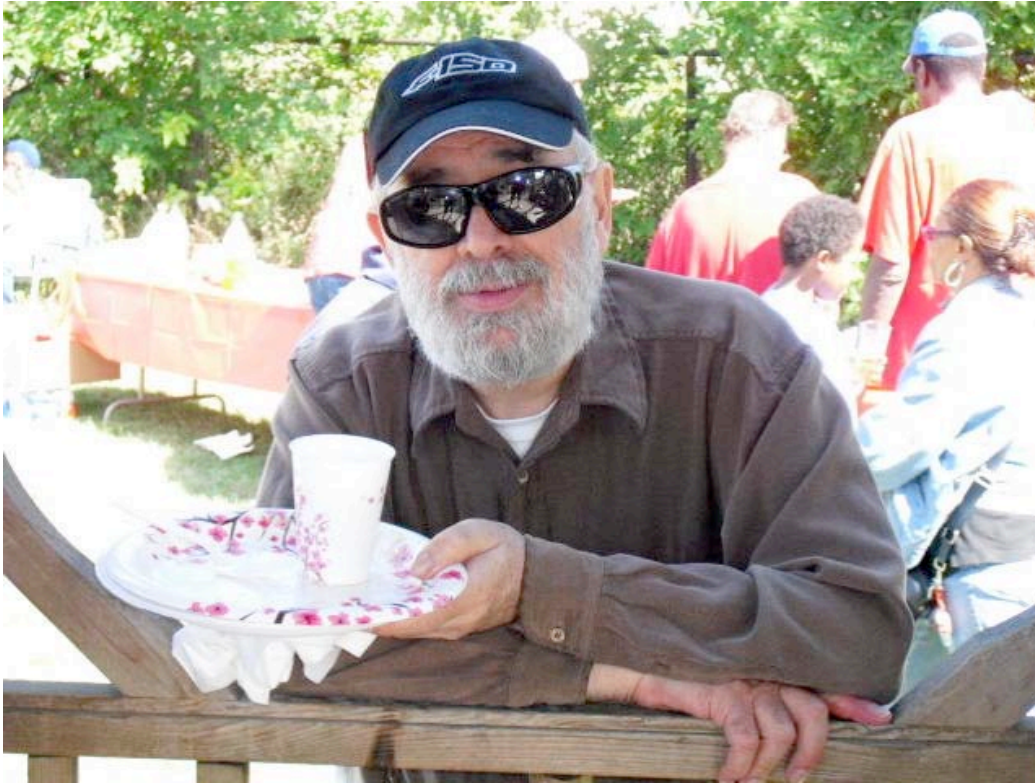
- This is the last weekend to buy 50/50 raffle tickets. raffle tickets See Samantha or Norbert.
