TOGETHER IN FAITH

Our journey “together in faith” continues. Several Rosary members have wondered what “Together in Faith” (TIF) has to do with merging with St. Patrick and St. Aloysius. TIF is the name given to the program throughout the entire Archdiocese to take a look at all ways parishes can adapt to changing situations, in and out of the Church, to make the Catholic Faith community more able to reflect Christ’s presence in our area. One of the “changing situations” has to do with the decrease in the number of priests. With approximately 250 parishes in the Archdiocese, and approximately 225 priests in the Archdiocese, it does not take a lot of math studies to see that if, as Archbishop Vigneron has mandated, “every parish must have a shepherd”—a pastor—then the reasoning behind the merging becomes clear. Therefore, merging is one aspect of the entire TIF process—an aspect that perhaps touches all of us most deeply.

Father Loren of St. Aloysius and St. Patrick has shared his insight into this process. Rather than “merging” with the feeling of forceful pushing together, he suggests we think of “emerging”—rising out of current circumstances to produce a new outlook, a new entity. Rosary is committed to merging with these two parishes—“There is no other option.”

As we continue the process, another opportunity to get to know the people of the other two parishes will be next Saturday, August 31—the annual St. Patrick parish picnic. It will be held at Brainard Park—between Cass and Second, one block north of Martin Luther King—about a block from St. Patrick church. The park is a very pleasant spot, perfect for a summer late afternoon. Why not bring a dish to share and join the fun??
