**Janet Dolin, who graduated from the Rosary schools and who visits Rosary often, sent a longer remembrance:**

**“Well I remember him! Initially, I think, I presumed that he was a rather “peculiar member’ sort of lurking in the background of the church, and not very sociable-not smelling very good—perhaps drawn in by the smell of coffee. However, later on, I realized ‘that such as he might be Our Lord—only in a different manifestation—the “One to be invited and welcomed in our midst.” (When you did it for the LEAST of these my brothers, you did it for ME.)**

**And then I became COMFORTABLE with the “VISITOR” in the corner who, for whatever reason chose (his choice) to remain rather “distant but to be ONE WITH US. How fortunate we were to have had him in our midst. I wish that I had been able (tried) to connect with him more than I did...**

**Any plans for memorial/funeral as still being developed. As an unidentified homeless person, the morgue will hold the body for about 45 days.**
