The Black Catholic Ministries presents the Phenomenal Woman Conference, "Created in the Image of God" April 20. Brochures are available at church.

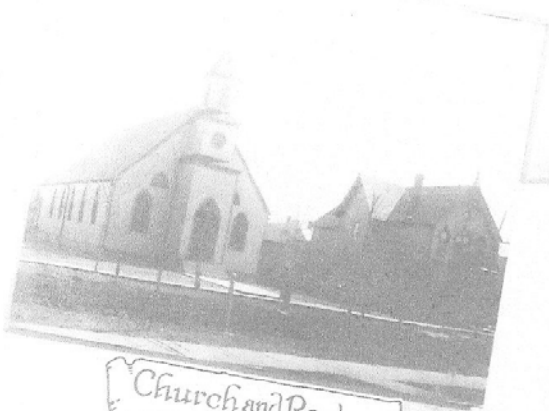
FINANCES

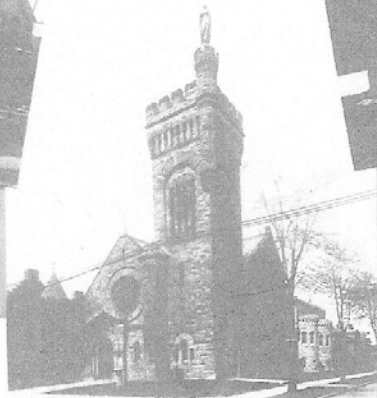

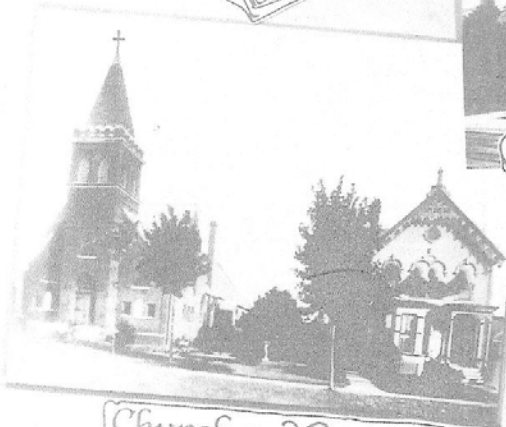
Church and Rectory

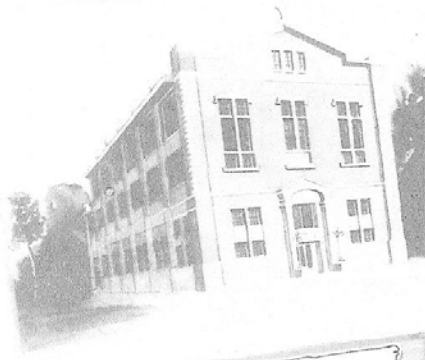

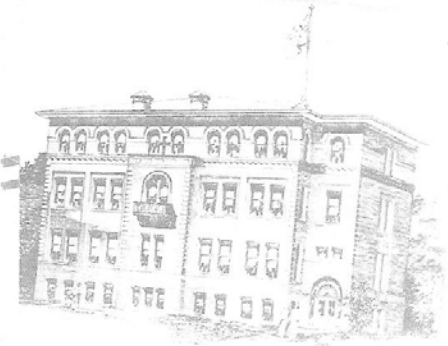

This is a “souvenir” of Rosary’s 25th anniversary in 1914—almost 100 years ago. The first church and rectory and convent were on Harper, on the land we still own behind the gas station. The large 1914 rectory was on Woodward, right in the middle of what is now the Ford Freeway (I 94). The two school buildings were built on the site of the first church and rectory, and lasted until 1978—first as various versions of the Rosary grade and high schools, then as Salesian High School, then as the Detroit Free School and finally as a home for Concept East Theater. Father Van Antwerp oversaw all this, from 1889 – 1930.
