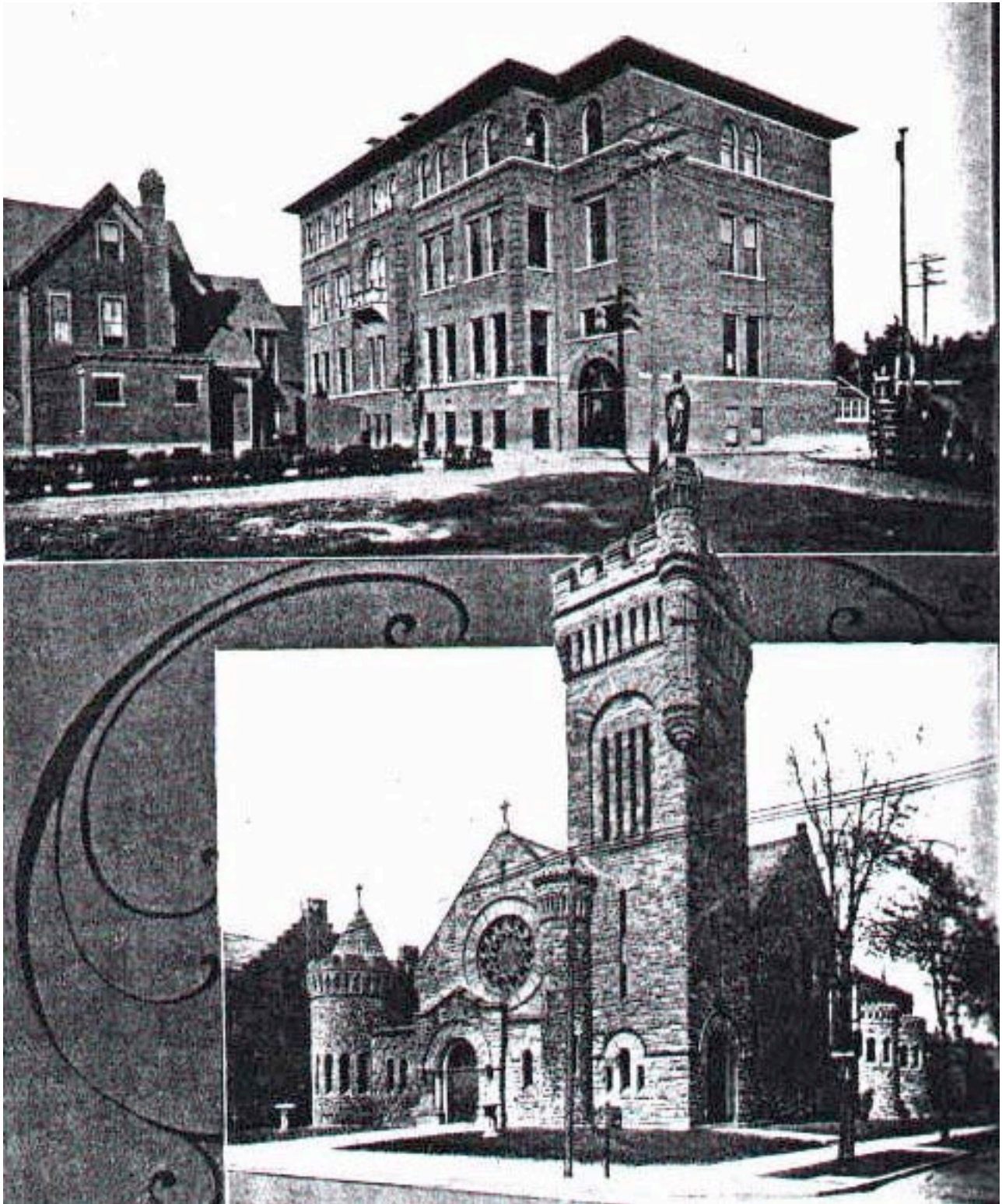

A LITTLE MORE ROSARY HISTORY



This was the Rosary Ushers' Club in 1899. Father Francis Van Antwerp, the founding Pastor is very obvious in the second row. (Hmmm...the photographer must have cut Norbert out of the photo.)



This composite photo shows Rosary around 1910. The top photo is the first wing of the parish school—right behind where the gas station is today. Eventually the house on the left hand side was torn down and the high school building was built there—an L shaped educational complex. The photo of the church has a few big differences from today's church. Note the nice lawns, the bird baths, the mail box on the corner and, most noticeable, the way the statue of Mary is mounted on a pedestal extending from the tower itself.
