ADULT MEDICAL PROGRAM ENROLLMENT

Open enrollment for Adult Medical Program (Plan A) health coverage is from April 1 – 30, 2013. This applies to adults, 18 – 64, with no minor children in the home, US citizens or legal residents, and no income or low income (\$335/mo single, \$452 married. If working, \$618/mo single, \$765 married couple). This plan pays for basic medical care, has low or no co-pays and provides more coverage than the county Health Plan B. ROSARY PARISH COUNCIL

There was a joint meeting of the Parish Council and the Finance Committee last week. Basically, members exchanged ideas, opinions and insight on ways to plan Rosary's future. One point made early in the meeting was that there are too many rumors floating around about Rosary's future. The councils affirmed the need to deal with facts rather than rumors and emotions. Darlene Oubre gave us a powerful message: "Remember what Father Morand always told us: 'Just keep on keeping on.'" With this in mind, it is very important that we, as a Parish Family, present the image of an active, viable parish. How? First, try to come to Mass as often as possible. We do not want any visitor to come here and see that ½ the congregation is "on vacation" that day. This would not impress anyone. Encourage family members to join you each week. And---most importantly---try to bring visitors to Mass. We aren't going to twist their arms to register at Rosary or even to join the Church. We need to reach out, and one-on-one invitations have always been effective ways to do this. The councils spoke about evangelization. How do we do this, beyond inviting others to join us? We need to look at what other churches are doing, both Catholic and non-Catholic. If you receive notices, ads, etc. from other churches listing their activities, etc. please bring them to Rosary. If you have ideas about reaching out, especially to our neighbors, share them with any Parish Council member. One more way to demonstrate our viability---collections. A few months ago we presented financial data that showed only about ½ of the people accepting Offertory envelopes actually used them. Use of envelopes is one measure of involvement of parishioners. In addition, we suggested that a weekly offertory collection of about \$2000 was needed in order for us to meet our budget. We have been publishing the weekly total in the bulletin—and too many weekly collections fall short of the goal. It is crucial right now that we demonstrate our activity and viability as a parish community. Does the survival of Rosary mean anything to you? Are you doing your part?

FINANCES

Last week our collection totaled \$2864, partly because of a lot of visitors. 46 envelopes were used.
