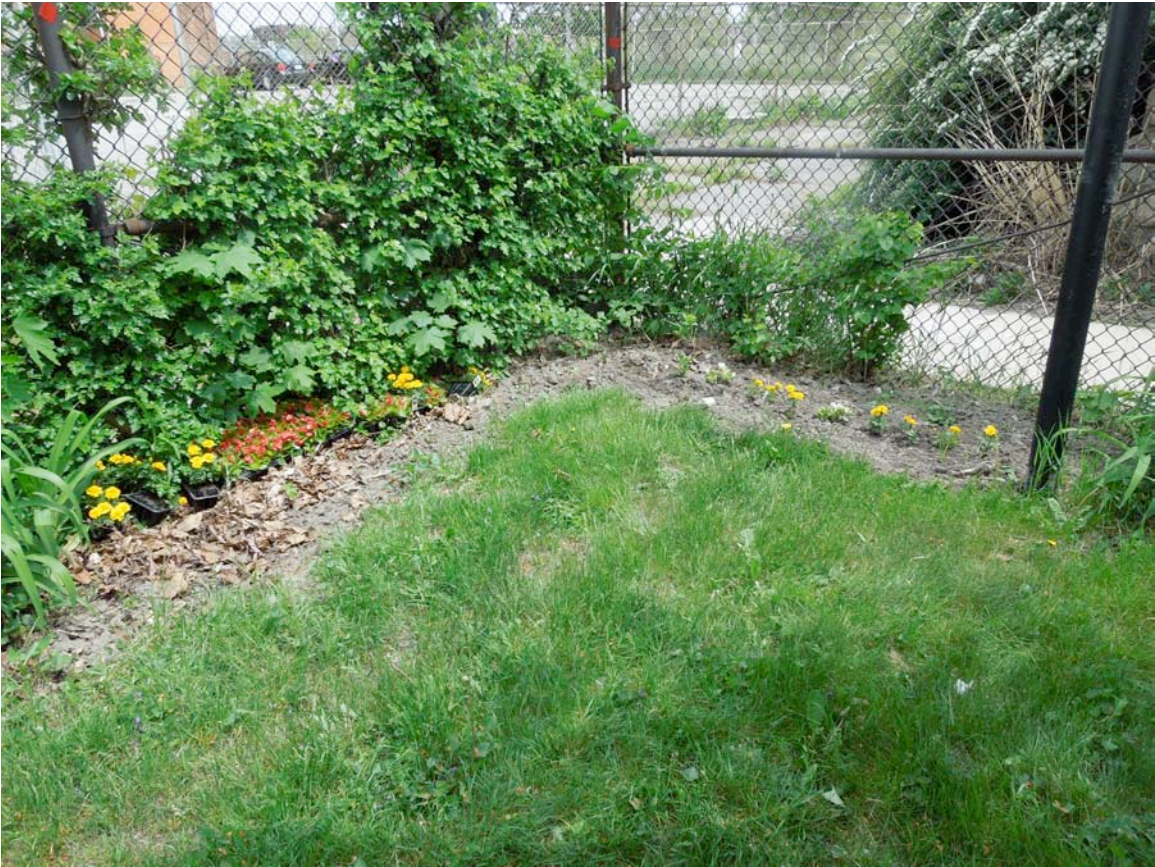


**Mothers, Grandmothers, Godmothers were all honored with a special blessing during Mass last Sunday.**
