Also, the play is being written by Aaron Timlin, son of Hugh Timlin—the architect/artist who designed the renovated church interior. There were two other highlights of the evening. First, our friend Alberta Asmar was surprised by being honored for all the things she does for the Alliance that are never recognized. She received a beautiful floral arrangement.
