Tuesday is election day in Detroit and many communities. Please remember to cast your vote. ONE vote can decide an election. Do your part.

NOVEMBER

November traditionally has been the month to focus on our departed brothers and sisters and to pray for their eternal rest. At Rosary we have a book where the names of our departed members and friends are recorded on an on-going basis. However, if you have personal friends or family members we many have missed, our book will be displayed near the front entrance during November. Feel free to add names you want us to include when we pray for the departed.

PERCEPTIONS OF THE FAITHFUL

The Archdiocese is conducting a survey of all the Catholics in this area to get a “feeling” for the way Catholics view the Church here. This survey is totally anonymous; no names are used. It is basically a two-page checklist asking you to rate church actions in the seven pastoral priority areas: Education, Christian Service, Evangelization, Lay Leadership, Stewardship, Vocations and Youth. In addition, there is a section where you are asked to what happens in your parish. Copies of this survey and the Archbishop’s letter introducing this process are included with this week’s bulletin. Additional copies are available. In addition, you can complete and submit the survey on line: survey.aod.org All surveys must be completed, either on line or on the hard copy, by next Sunday, November 10. Let’s be sure the Archdiocese has our opinions recorded as feedback from the faithful. Even though these are anonymous, the overall tone of our responses will carry weight as decisions are made.

SERVING THOSE WHO SERVE

Did you know there is a special archdiocese for the Military Services, maintained by an archbishop, four auxiliary bishops and 250 Catholic chaplains. This ministry is extended to Catholics in the armed forces, all over the world, and to the military academies. In addition, 250 more chaplains serve patients in Veteran's military facilities---like the VA Hospital a few blocks away from Rosary. This archdiocese has no parishes, no schools, no buildings. Absolutely no funding comes from the government. The military chaplain program depends on donations from the faithful and private grants to train seminarians and to continue to work with our military men and women—wherever they are. Next weekend, the Archdiocese of Detroit will become involved in this mission. A special collection for the Military Archdiocese will be taken up. This is very appropriate because it happens the day before Veteran's Day, when we thankfully recall the sacrifices of men and women for our country. So many veterans recall the impact of priest chaplains on their lives in the midst of battles, in dealing with homesickness, etc. Envelopes will be distributed this weekend. Please be generous.

MASS FOR DECEASED CLERGY

Each November the Archdiocese has a special Mass for all deceased clergymen. This year, a special invitation has been extended to Rosary as Fr. Morand is especially remembered. Fr.'s family and "those parishioners particularly close to Fr. Morand" are invited to this celebration. It will be Monday, November 25, at 11 AM at Sacred Heart Seminary. We are being asked to submit the number of attendees by tomorrow. Talk to Norbert after Mass.
