In this classic photo Eugene Markowski is with his best friend Katy Gosinski. They came to Rosary in the mid 1970s and became good friends of the entire parish. They lived in adult foster care homes. In the 1970s, they were responsible for cleaning the church each week, a job they took very seriously. Eugene was associated with making coffee each week. He would always give the sports news: “Tigers won last night.” When you would agree, his response was “That’s right!” About six or seven years ago his health became such that he could not join us for Mass each week. He and Katy shared an apartment on the Wayne State Campus and were fortunate to have a wonderful group of care-givers who assisted them. Katy still comes to Rosary regularly and would give us a report on Eugene. When we talked to her about Eugene’s death her concern was that the whole parish would know about this. Funeral arrangements are being arranged by Eugene’s legal guardian. We are fortunate to have known Eugene so well. His story and his personality have surely inspired us as we continue our special ministry to residents of area adult foster care homes. Let’s keep Eugene in our prayers, and let’s show extra consideration to Katy when she joins us for Mass.
