TOGETHER IN FAITH

Our parish town-hall meeting last week brought the Rosary Family together with one concern: the future of Rosary. Parishioners shared questions, concerns and opinions. Mr. James from the Archdiocese went to great lengths to clarify our options. The meeting lasted until after 2 PM. At the end of the town hall, a questionnaire was distributed asking for a person's current feeling about merger—yes, or no. It was stressed that this was NOT a vote, but just an indication of how Rosary members feel about the future at this point. Fifty people returned the questionnaire—48 favored merger, 2 opposed. (Many attendees had to leave early and did not get a chance to express their feelings.) The transition team is planning committee meetings to delve deeper into the issues we face and to gather more information from Archdiocesan officials. Another town-hall will be scheduled in the future when more definite answers can be provided to questions.
