## ***CHANGING LIVES TOGETHER***

Last Sunday Mr. Koren Ruiz from the O'Meara Ferguson Company spoke to us after Mass. He explained again the purpose of the Changing Lives Together campaign and answered several questions. Among his answers was the information that if Rosary does not reach its goal, money will NOT be taken from our deposit with the Archdiocese to cover the deficit. Also, he outlined the "mechanics" of making payments: basically, once the commitment cards are turned in, all payments and communications will take place by mail. The parish is not handling any payments. The parish will begin to receive 70% of all payments in an on-going manner as payments are made.

Now it's up to us. The parish part of this campaign will be wrapped up by March 16—three weeks from today. What we've had pledged by that date is what we will deal with. Please return your commitment card this week or next. We do have extras in case you lost yours. Let's see how we as a parish can work to meet our goal.
