CHANGING LIVES TOGETHER

The final stage of Changing Lives Together (CLT) is happening right now. The commitment cards that have been distributed should be returned this weekend or next. They may be dropped in the Offertory collection. No money is needed at this time. The cards will be submitted to the Archdiocese and you will receive information about how to make payments on your pledge. Please think seriously about what you can do to assist Rosary. Remember, 70% of any money donated goes right to Rosary.

LENT

As we move forward on our Lenten journey, we invite you to take one of the small books put out by the Diocese of Saginaw, and spend three or four minutes each day reading the interesting story on the left side of the page, then a few minutes carefully thinking about the Scripture passage on the right side of the page. Also, folders for the “Rice Bowl” project of Catholic Relief Services are available. Fold the cardboard into a small box and put your Lenten offerings in each day. Return the box on Holy Thursday or on Easter. We have had the custom of celebrating the Stations of the Cross twice during Lent, followed by a bread and soup meal. The dates this year are Wednesday, March 26 and Wednesday, April 9 at 6 PM. We will be inviting you to bring some of a favorite home-made soup to share. Watch for details—but pencil in these dates so you will plan to be here.

Another wonderful Lenten practice is to join our Bible Study group. As is their practice, this group will meet every Monday evening in Lent at 7 PM in the parish house. This Monday the texts to be read and discussed are: Leviticus 19: 1-2, 11 – 18, and Matthew 25: 31 – 46.
