CATHOLIC SERVICES APPEAL

Our CSA total is now close to \$2,400—with the goal of \$7,000 still in the distance. (This current total came from donations of only 12 Rosary parishioners!) The CSA campaign is supposed to wrap up this weekend, but since Rosary delayed the start for a few weeks we still have some time to reach the goal. Try to figure out what amount you might be able to spare each month, then multiply this by 9 months to get the amount of your donation. For example, if you could spare \$20 per month—that's \$5 per week—your donation would be \$180 for the year. If we could get 30 more people to pledge \$20 per month, we would meet our quota. Any amount above our quota comes right back to Rosary. The important thing to keep in mind is that Rosary has never failed to meet its CSA quota. Let's show the diocese that Rosary is still ready and able to meet its challenges.

Many bring in the envelopes representing Sundays they could not be here the following week. Still others actually mail in contributions so their offerings and envelopes can be counted in the weekly “progress” report. Let’s keep aiming for our budget goal...at least \$2200 per week. There are only five more Sundays in this fiscal year and we are really trying to show “everyone” that Rosary can meet its budget!
