## ***FINANCES AND BEYOND!***

Last weekend our count of Offertory envelopes was 55! The collection amounted to \$2135. As we near the end of this fiscal year, it seems appropriate to thank the Rosary Family for working so hard to help us meet the budget we prepared last year. This could have been a disastrous year for Rosary. So many things were unsettled. True to our Rosary tradition, we all worked together to help meet the spiritual and material needs of the parish. Teams of parishioners assisted in so many projects ranging from church cleaning to doing repairs to helping with our outreach mission. Our garden flourished, our Christmas basket project was a big success, our annual party for residents of Adult Foster Care Homes provided a lot of fun and love, our retreat program for the developmentally disadvantaged touched the lives of several hundred people. We celebrated Sister Joan's 60<sup>th</sup> jubilee, welcomed several new parishioners and prayed together—a lot! We got to know many new priests who helped celebrate with us: Fr. Bob Molloy, Fr. John, Fr. Hyde, Fr. Watson, Fr. Chamberlain and, of course, our Administrator Monsignor Lefevre. We pulled together to meet the goal for Offertory collections, the goal for Changing Lives Together and the goal for the Catholic Services Appeal. Through careful use of our resources, even with unexpected boiler problem, we are financially sound.

The finance committee has put together the budget for 2014 – 2015. There is a very small increase in our goal for offertory collections and money budgeted for various expenses---utilities, repairs, etc. The question of budgeting for priest service was challenging and the estimated figures in the budget will be “tested” as the year unfolds. The entire new budget will be available within the next two weeks.

Monsignor Lefevre wishes to express his gratitude to all the Rosary Family for the love and support we show for our parish. Our dedication to our Rosary as we celebrate 125 years is certainly noticed!
