REVIVE!

The REVIVE program will begin in a little more than one week. There is room for only about 100 people from our Vicariate. Rosary will surely want to be represented. Think seriously about participating. Have you ever wondered about things that are said or done at Mass? Has it been a while since you have even had an “update” on your knowledge of Catholicism? Even if you attended Catholic schools, there are new aspects of the Faith to delve into. Have you even wished you could have a closer relationship with God? Have you ever wondered how to pray? Have you ever wondered why God permits evil in the world? The Archdiocese has planned this program, REVIVE, to address these concerns. For 11 weeks on Wednesday evenings, beginning August 27, dynamic speakers will update your knowledge of Catholicism, and you will have the opportunity to discuss your concerns. There is NO fee for this, and a free meal will be served. Free child care is provided. The series will be held in our own neighborhood –the Sacred Heart Parish activities building. Parking is free and secured. The series begins August 27, 6:45 – 9 PM. This program responds to Pope Francis’ call for us all to “mature in our work as evangelizers,” and “have better training, a deepening love and a clearer witness to the Gospels.” Think about being at this event.
