CELEBRATE DR. KING

Monday, January 19 is the official holiday celebrating the life and legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. We have a few suggestions about ways you could observe this day:

The annual Mass will be held at Blessed Sacrament Cathedral at 10 AM. Bishop Gumbleton will be the celebrant. This would be a wonderful spiritual day to celebrate Dr. King's accomplishments.

The annual Rally and March for Jobs, Peace and Justice will be held at Central Methodist Church, 23 E. Adams at Woodward at noon Monday. This year's theme, "Continuing the Struggle for Civil Rights and Democracy—from Selma, 1965 to Detroit, 2015" is especially meaningful. This would be a great event for the younger generation to get insight into the world Dr. King helped change.

MATRIX THEATER

The first play of 2015 at Matrix is "Cain's Row," a play written by the Matrix Theatre Company's Writers Circle. Do you know anyone who has been in jail or prison. 1 out of every 31 Americans is or has been incarcerated, paroled, or under some form of supervision. This play examines the lives of two brothers. After serving eight months in prison, their lives have changed. How? Why? This is a play well worth seeing.
