FINANCES

Last weekend, \$ 1,870 was contributed. 58 envelopes were used. While this is an admirable number of envelopes, it still barely represents ½ of the envelopes distributed. A few words about our budget. To balance our budget, we need at least \$2200 per week in Offertory donations. We were doing very well until the end of December. Now, in January, our first four weekly offerings were: \$1,609, \$1,845, \$1,654, and \$ 1, 870 giving us a total of \$6, 978. This is good—but our budget calls for us to have raised \$8,800, a difference of \$1,822. Let's all think about what Rosary means to us and examine the amounts of our donations. If we could get more people to use envelopes, and if each person increased his/her donation by a few dollars, we would be able to meet our goal.
