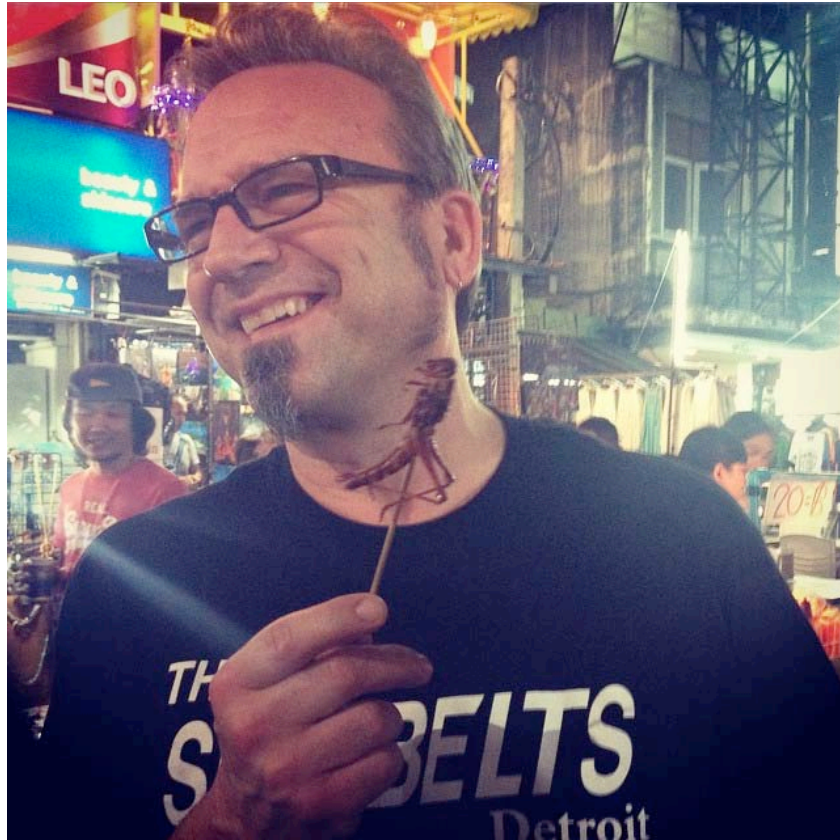
Leonard, in between bites, found time to preside over his table—Shaun Nethercott, Barbara Murdock and Nelson Lewis (soon to be his Best Man!).
