- The books from the Diocese of Saginaw are available. They provide daily Scriptural passages and thought-provoking articles
- The Rice Bowl folders are again available. The idea is to collect change each day (empty your pockets!) and deposit in the cardboard box, then bring the offering to church on Holy Thursday or Easter.
- As is our custom during Lent, the Bible Study group will meet every Monday at 7:00 PM in the Parish House. The texts being studies this week are—
 - Isaiah 55: 10 – 11
 - Matthew 6: 7 - 15
