PROPOSAL 1

In two weeks, Michigan will vote on Proposal 1, which basically asks us to raise our sales tax from 6 % to 7 % to finance road repairs. The actual process is very complicated. The Detroit Catholic Pastoral Alliance's Community Action Committee and the Black Women Lawyers Association of Michigan are presenting a community forum, "The Facts about Proposal 1" on Monday, April 20 at 6:30 PM in the Sacred Heart Parish Activities Building. The presenter will be Michigan State Representative Leslie Love. It is important that we inform ourselves of all aspects of this proposal before we vote.

CATHOLIC SERVICES APPEAL

As we get closer to May, we get closer to the annual Catholic Services Appeal (CSA). By now we are familiar with the goal of this campaign and the process by which the funds are raised. This year our assigned quota is slightly over \$7,000—basically the same as last year. We reached the goal last year—and we can do it again this year! Watch for more details as the CSA campaign gets under way.

A REMINDER

As we prepare for the transition from Monsignor LeFevre to Fr. Mech this summer, it would be well to remind ourselves that Rosary is not a "stand-alone" parish. We are officially clustered with Blessed Sacrament Cathedral and St. Moses the Black. While we have our worship site, our name, our bank account, our on-going projects, etc. we must remember that we are part of a cluster. We have experienced the "cluster feeling" when we joined the other parishes for a picnic, for worship on several occasions, etc. This feeling of togetherness will continue to grow.

HELP FOR UKRAINE

Vickie Koivu-Rybicki, a frequent worshipper at Rosary, is involved in an effort to provide aid to the people of Ukraine. The recent fighting and destruction there has created a true humanitarian crisis. The Save Ukraine Now committee is asking for the help of Catholics for this traditionally Catholic Country. A prayer breakfast will launch an effort to gather clothing, etc. to send to the people of Ukraine.
