ST. PATRICK IRISH FESTIVAL

The annual Irish Festival is today, Sunday, June 28, 1 – 9 PM at the St. Patrick Senior Center, 58 Parsons. This festival provides much of the funding for the St. Patrick Senior Center (not part of the former St. Patrick Parish) providing food, medical care, counseling and fun to the seniors in the area. Admission is \$5 for adults, \$1 for children 12 and under. Try to drop by—and let them know you're from Rosary. There will be food, Irish music, items for sale, fun for the whole family!

A MISSIONARY GUEST

Fr. Librado Baluarte from the Diocese of Sorsogon in the Philippines will be visiting our cluster parishes next weekend (Blessed Sacrament, St. Moses the Black and Rosary). He will speak at one Mass here to tell us about the tremendous needs of the Church in his diocese. Specifically, he will be looking for financial help to assist the education of 150 seminarians and to assist with the diocesan program to prepare lay men and women to effectively assist priests in programs to focus on the economic, political, cultural and religious development of the people. This diocese is one of the poorest in the region, and frequently hit by natural calamities—hurricanes, volcanic eruptions, etc. Let's welcome Fr. Baluarte and generously assist him.

PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN

Again, the Archdiocese is offering a training program aimed at preventing any form of abuse in church-related activities. The memo clearly states: **“WORKSHOP PARTICIPATION IS REQUIRED FOR ALL PAID STAFF AND EVERY VOLUNTEER WHO WORKS WITH CHILDREN, THE ELDERLY, OR DISABLED ON A ONE TIME OR REGULAR BASIS.”** Many Rosary volunteers have already completed this training. We need to aim for 100% of our volunteers being trained. The one-time workshop is Saturday, July 25 at Blessed Sacrament Cathedral, 10 AM – 1 PM. Norbert will be distributing flyers with the information for pre-registration, which is required.
