“OFFICIAL BUSINESS”—ONE MORE TIME

Following Church policy when a parish is closed, we are reprinting the decree of the Archbishop which divided up the territory of St. Patrick. Rosary’s new boundaries are: South to Martin Luther King Blvd., West to 12th Street/Rosa Parks, North to East/West Grand Boulevard and East to the Chrysler Freeway. By reprinting the decree in the bulletin we hope to avoid any parishioner feeling that he/she was not notified of the changes.

The actual decree is framed and positioned at the entrance to the church. If you would like a certified copy of the decree, talk to Norbert.

On June 18, 2015, Archbishop Allen Vigneron issued a decree that distributes the parish boundaries of the former St. Patrick Parish to neighboring parishes effective July 15, 2015. This means that Our Lady of the Rosary Parish will have a larger area in the core of the City. For two weekends, that is until July 12, the aforementioned decree that describes our new parish boundaries will be placed at the entrance of our church for review. Last weekend, because of a change in travel plans, the Sunday Mass congregation had the wonderful opportunity to meet Fr. Librado Baluarte, a priest from the Philippines. Father gave us a concise look at Philippine history, highlighting how the Church has worked to uplift the people and praising the United States especially for our part in liberating the Philippines during World War II. He is searching for funds to assist his home diocese, perhaps the poorest in the Philippines.
