FAITH FOR FIFTEEN

Father Norm Thomas invites us to join him in supporting the Faith for Fifteen campaign of the Interfaith Committee on Worker Justice. This campaign is an

effort to raise wages in low-paying industries such as the fast-food and retail areas. These low-wage employees struggle to pay bills and raise families. While other areas offer low wages, these particular areas are those run by corporations that have the resources to raise worker wages. Pope Francis encourages the Church to work toward “the three L’s...land, lodging and labor.” This campaign involves engaging congregations in the struggle for just wages. On Monday, August 17, the Alliance will sponsor a Lunch and Learn at Sacred Heart Activities Building from 11 AM to 1 PM. Presentations will include information on low-wage jobs, an explanation of the Faith for Fifteen campaign and testimonies from workers. Lunch will be provided.
